2 HOURS CE CREDIT



- ① Register before leaving
- ① Out of County receipt
- ① State Licenses (QAL, QAC, PCA, Pilot)
- ① County Private Applicator Certificates

CERTIFIED APPLICATORS

- ⊙ Allows use and supervision of restricted material (Federal, California, Groundwater)
- ⊙ Allows training of handlers and fieldworkers
- ⊙ 6 hours in three years for Private Applic.
- ⊙ 20 hours in two years for QAL, QAC
- ⊙ List of approved classes:

- ③ Must be signed by owner/operator or authorized agent

08/09 RECAP

- ◎ 122 inspections
- ◎ 8 Non-Compliances

◎ Records inspections:

- ◎ 21 inspections
- ◎ 8 Non-Compliances

◎ Complaints/Illnesses/Investigations:

- ◎ 19 incidents
- ◎ 10 Non-Compliances



08/09 RECAP, CONTINUED

- ① 12973 Label violation-PPE, not registered, etc.
- ① Drift, Suitable climatic conditions
- ① Late Pesticide Use Reports, Operator ID #
- ① Storage locked, Posted, Emergency Medical Information
- ① Labeling not available (incl. supplements)
- ① Non-Pesticide related complaints



08/09 RECAP, CONTINUED

- ⊙ Respiratory Regulation
- ⊙ For Employees Required to wear Respirators
- ⊙ Written program
- ⊙ Trained annually
- ⊙ Medical Evaluation
- ⊙ Annual Fit Testing



NOTIFICATION REGULATION



- ◎ Adopted September, 2009
- ◎ Enforcement began January, 2010
- ◎ Clarification of existing requirements for employees, contractors
- ◎ Added requirement for non-employees

NOTIFICATION REGULATION

- ◎ **Pest Control Businesses** are required to give notice of proposed applications and notice of application completion to property operators.
- ◎ The **Property Operators** are then required to notify employees, labor contractors, etc. who may go within $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of the application site.



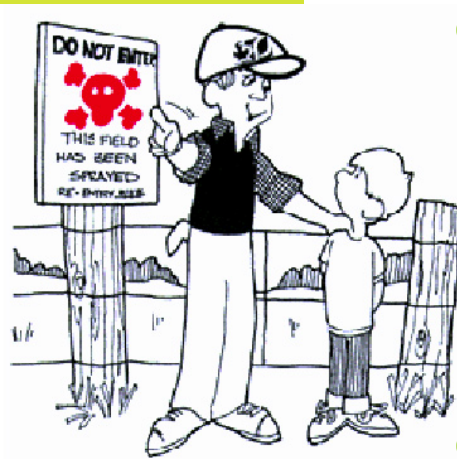
NOTIFICATION REGULATION, CONT.



- ◎ Notices must contain:
 - ◎ date of scheduled application,
 - ◎ location of field to be treated,
 - ◎ product info,
 - ◎ precautions,
 - ◎ REI (Restricted Entry Interval)

- ◎ Any change requires re-notification

NOTIFICATION REGULATION, CONT.



*Observe re-entry times as specified
on the product label!*

- ⊙ Notification of non-employees
- ⊙ **Only** required if operator has reason to believe someone may enter field during REI
- ⊙ Not required if field is posted
