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Guidelines for Project Proficiency Award

BEGINNING (First & Second Years)

COLOR:

1. Learn color family names (hues).
2. Choose your favorite color.
3. Choose colors for an article to go with other colors in the room.

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TEXTURE:

1. Recognized different textures by feeling, handling and looking at them.
2. Identify textures of the setting where article will be place.
3. Identify textures of article.

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DESIGN:

1. Identify lines and shapes of setting where article will be used.
2. Use a line design as decoration for article.

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SPACE:

1. Identify examples of two and three dimensional space in your home.
2. Measure space where article will be placed.
3. Plan the size and shape of article to fit the space where it will be placed.

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CONSUMER INFORMATION:
