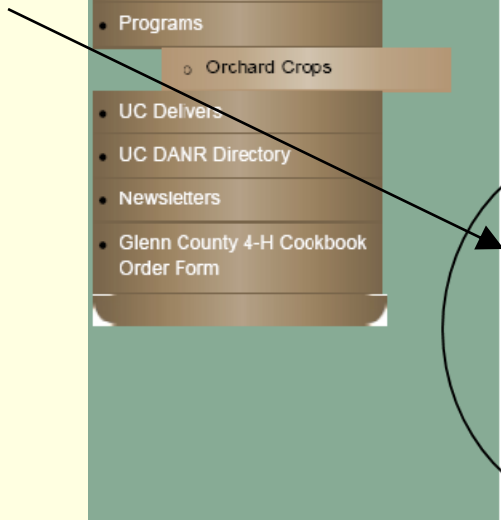

Olives

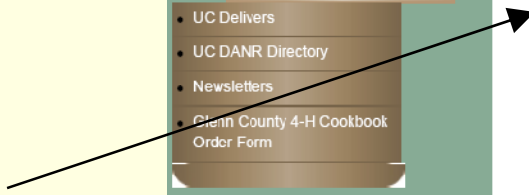

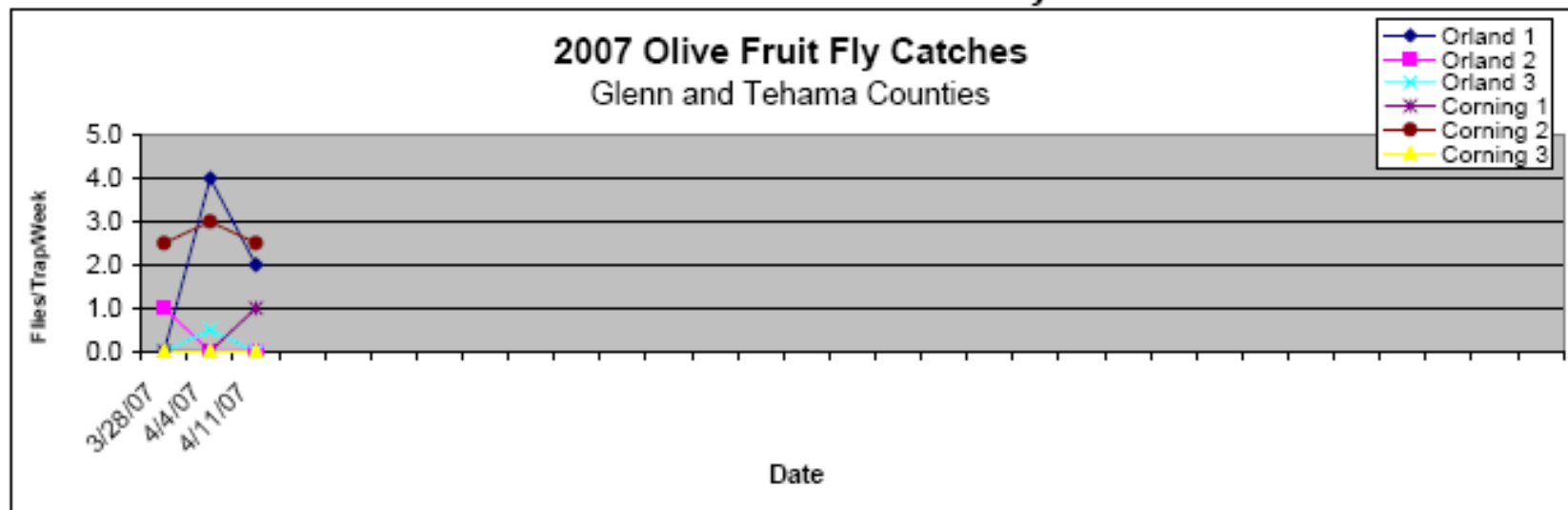

2008 Trapping Results

- Trap catches peaked June to July
- Dropped off with onset of high temperatures
- Did not resume with cooler weather as much as in the past.
 - Majority in one site
 - Seven of 10 sites caught no flies after July 13th
