


2013 Fumigation Season Review:

- APPROXIMATELY 350 FIELD FUMIGATIONS
- OVER 4,000 ACRES FUMIGATED
- THE MAIN FUMIGANTS USED INCLUDE:
 - METHYL BROMIDE
 - 1,3-DICHLOROPROPENE
 - CHLOROPICRIN
 - METAM POTASSIUM


Fumigations by Month

Reminders for 2014

- BE AWARE OF WEATHER CONDITIONS AHEAD OF PROPOSED FUMIGATIONS:
 - FORECASTED WINDY CONDITIONS
 - FORECASTED WEATHER INVERSIONS
 - TEMPERATURES ABOVE 85° BEFORE AND AFTER
 THE FUMIGATION

MAKE SURE FUMIGATED FIELDS HAVE THE REQUIRED DANGER POSTINGS AND THAT SIGNS STAY UP UNTIL TARP REMOVAL

Reminders for 2014

- REMEMBER THAT BUFFER ZONE SIGNS MUST BE VISIBLE
- NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN THE BUFFER ZONE
 EXCEPT TO TRANSIT BY BICYCLE OR VEHICLE
- ENSURE THAT YOUR EMPLOYEES AND OTHERS
 STAY OUT OF <u>BUFFER ZONES</u> IN BY-STANDER
 AREAS SUCH AS <u>PARKING AREAS</u> BY MARKING THE
 AREA OFF LIMITS WITH "CAUTION" TAPE OR
 CONES AND BY ENSURING THE AREA IS PROPERLY
 POSTED

2014 Santa Cruz County Conditions

- A FUMIGATION WORK PLAN MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR EVALUATION
- APPLICATIONS MUST DONE BY A PEST CONTROL BUSINESS
- TARPS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL APPLICATIONS
- ONLY TARPS HAVING A 60% OR GREATER
 BUFFER REDUCTION AS LISTED BY E.P.A. MUST
 BE USED

2014 Santa Cruz County Conditions

 TARPS MUST NOT BE PERFORATED UNTIL 9 DAYS (216 HRS) HAVE ELAPSED AFTER THE APPLICATION AND CANNOT BE REMOVED UNTIL A MINIMUM OF 24 HOURS AFTER PERFORATION

- BUFFER ZONE CREDITS ARE ONLY ALLOWED FOR:
 - THE USE OF APPROVED TARPS
 - POST-APPLICATION WATER TREATMENT FOR CHEMIGATION ONLY

What is ahead?

- DEPARTMENT OF PESTICIDE REGULATION (DPR) CHLOROPICRIN MITIGATION MEASURES
 - TO PROTECT BYSTANDERS AND RESIDENTS FROM ACUTE (SHORT-TERM) EXPOSURES TO CHLOROPICRIN
 - WILL AFFECT ALL FUMIGANTS THAT CONTAIN
 CHLOROPICRIN AS AN ACTIVE INGREDIENT

DPR Proposals

- DPR IS PROPOSING THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS IN ADDITION TO PESTICIDE LABEL REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS:
 - INCREASED BUFFER ZONES
 - BUFFER ZONE CREDITS ALLOWED ONLY FOR CERTAIN AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES SUCH AS THE USE OF TARPS OR POST WATER TREATMENT
 - MINIMUM BUFFER ZONES CURRENTLY 25 FEET
 WITH APPROVED TARP

DPR Proposals

- ACREAGE LIMITS
- OVERLAPPING BUFFER ZONES RESTRICTIONS
- NOTICE OF INTENT REQUIREMENTS 48 HRS
- TARP CUTTING FOR EPA APPROVED TARPS AT LEAST 9 DAYS MUST HAVE ELAPSED
- EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE
 - NOTIFICATIONS IN ENGLISH/SPANISH
 - OR IF MONITORING IS CHOSEN IT WILL BE AT SPECIFIC LOCATIONS
