OBJECTIVES AND REQUIREMENTS

The objective of this Recognition Award is to honor outstanding individuals, businesses or organizations and leadership by volunteers in the Madera County 4-H Program who have encouraged the following objectives for 4-H members.

- * Acquire an understanding of and appreciation for the Madera County 4-H Program and acquire skills necessary to conduct practices in planning, producing, managing and keeping records of 4-H activities.
- * * Acknowledge and explain to the public and other 4-H members, economic, recreational, aesthetic, social and self-rewarding benefits and their importance to the individual, the family, local communities, the State and the Nation.
- * Demonstrate sound educational 4-H practices on the farm, urban or in the community areas.
