No day-of registration will be allowed. Participants may compete in more than one species, but only one per time slot.

WHAT IS IT? The Livestock Challenge is an opportunity for members to demonstrate their livestock knowledge. This will *not* be a quiz bowl as in years past. Members will rotate through different stations and answer questions related to the species selected.

- ✓ Questions are taken from the livestock Challenge & livestock judging study guides. Additionally, members should be familiar with feeds & feed tags, parts of the animal, showmanship and conformation.
- ✓ Any 4-H member can enter, Junior Division (or 9 yrs. old by December 31, 2016) thru Senior Division. Primary members can participate in either the Rabbit, Dog, Cavy or Avian categories.
