Grant Programs of Interest - Agricultural

- **Moyer** - Carl Moyer Program
 - \$5.3M
- **FARMER** - Funding Agricultural Replacement Measures for Emission Reductions
 - \$1.2M

Maximum Grant Funding

Equipment Type	Project	Max Grant Funding
Off-road Equipment	Replacement	80% of eligible costs
Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV)	Electric Replacement	75% of eligible costs
Infrastructure	Agricultural Pump Electrification / Charging Stations	65% of eligible costs

Minimum Eligibility

- Minimum project eligibility requirements include, but not limited to:
 - Equipment must operate at least 75% within CA and at least 50% within San Diego County
 - Replacement equipment operational by April 30, 2021
 - 24 months of existing equipment ownership
 - In compliance with air quality regulations

Action Items - What You Need To Do Now

1. Sign-up for APCD email listserv
2. Gather usage documentation for the past 24 months
 - *Hour meter records, mileage, etc.*
3. Proof of equipment ownership
 - *Bill of sale, or other approved documentation*



Action Items - What You Need To Do Now

4. Gather vehicle and engine information
 - *Model numbers, serial numbers, horsepower, engine families, etc.*
5. Engines and equipment should have clean legible labels
6. Meet with vendors or dealers about proposed new equipment
7. **Be ready to submit an application to APCD**
