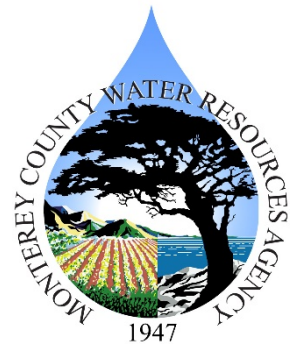


## Rangeland Management and Erosion Prevention Workshop
