The 2007 Cattle Tour starts at the ① Bob and Rita March Ranch on Island Road in Scott Valley

① March Ranch, 10:00:

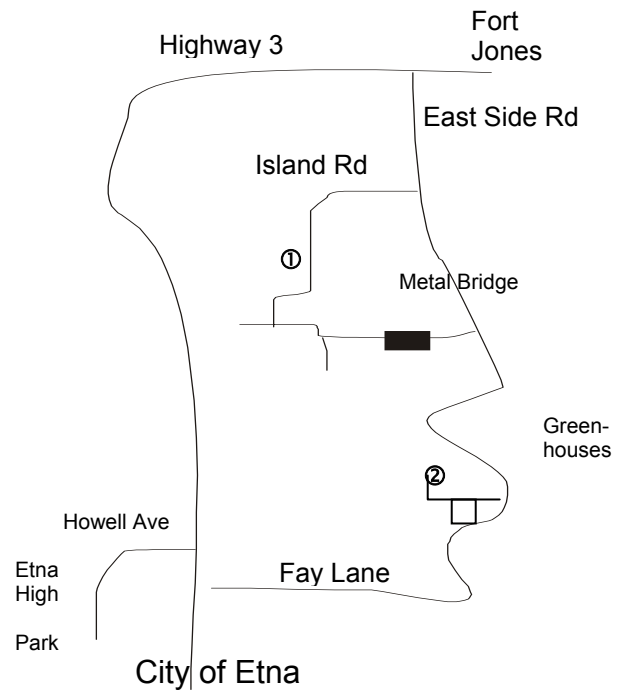
Take Hiway 3 to Fort Jones. Just after leaving Ft. Jones turn left on East Side Road. Go south about 2.3 mi. and turn right on Island Road. Follow Island Rd past the airport to the March Ranch, about 2.7 miles.

② Gareth Plank at the Whipple Ranch, 11:15

From March Ranch go south about 2 mi. turning left at the T intersection and going over the metal bridge. This takes you back to East Side Rd. Turn right going south on East Side Rd. Follow road about 4.6 miles to the Whipple Ranch and turn right at their shop going east. This is a dirt ranch road, watch for signs.

Lunch is at the Etna Park. From Whipple's go south on East Side road. Turn right at Faye Lane crossing the river. Turn right on Hiway 3 heading back to Etna. Go toward Etna High School on Howell Ave. Park is located just south of the school and pool.

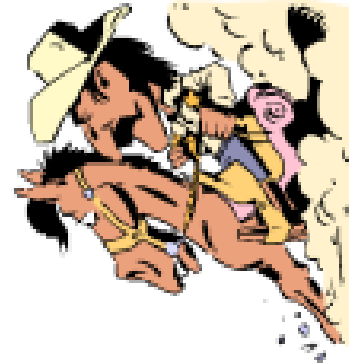
