

Kings County 4-H All Star Commitment

2020-2021 Program Year

By agreeing to become a Kings County 4-H All Star, you are making a commitment to this program, which should be of high priority. However, it is understood that a situation may arise that would cause you to need to miss a required event/activity. If this occurs, you must provide written documentation to the All Star Advisor stating the reason for your requested absence PRIOR to the event/activity in order to receive approval to miss the event/activity.

Term of Service:

- July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021

Requirements:

- Develop Leadership Activity/Event for Kings County 4-H members (as a team)
- Plan and Deliver Kings County 4-H Achievement Night Program (as a team)
- Plan Promotional Event(s)/Activity(ies) for National 4-H Week (as a team)
- Represent Kings County 4-H at a Board of Supervisor's Meeting (as a team)
- Evaluate/judge National 4-H Week Club Window Displays (as a team)
- Write and Submit a News Article for the Kings County Farm Bureau Newsletter (as a team)
- Create and Set-up 4-H Window Display at Kings County Board of Supervisors Office (as a team)
- Representation of All Star team at Leaders Council Meetings
- Participate on a Kings County 4-H County-wide Event Planning Committee AND attend event –1 committee minimum per All Star
- Submit an "All Star Spotlight" article for the Kings County 4-H Youth Talk – 1 minimum per All Star
- Participate during Tractor Supply Co Paper Clover Drive – minimum 2 hours per All Star
- Attend and be of assistance at Council Fundraiser, Food Olympics, Kings County Farm Day, and Fashion Revue – Minimum 2 per All Star
- Attend All Star Meetings – minimum 80% attendance per All Star
- Attend and be of assistance at Judging Day (each All Star)
- Attend and be of assistance at Presentation Day (each All Star)
- Attend and be of assistance at 4-H Fair (each All Star)
- Attend and be of assistance at 4-H Madness Event (each All Star)

- Complete Exit Application and Interview – you will discuss your leadership growth and development, highlights from your year of service, and any suggestions for improvements to the All Star program (each All Star)
- Optional – Attend State Leadership Conference, if you did not attend as an Ambassador; if you previously attended as an ambassador, scholarships (50%) are available.
- Other duties as assigned by advisor

Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, you will be eligible to apply for the Kings County All Star Scholarship.
