- **Irrigation and fertilizer management**

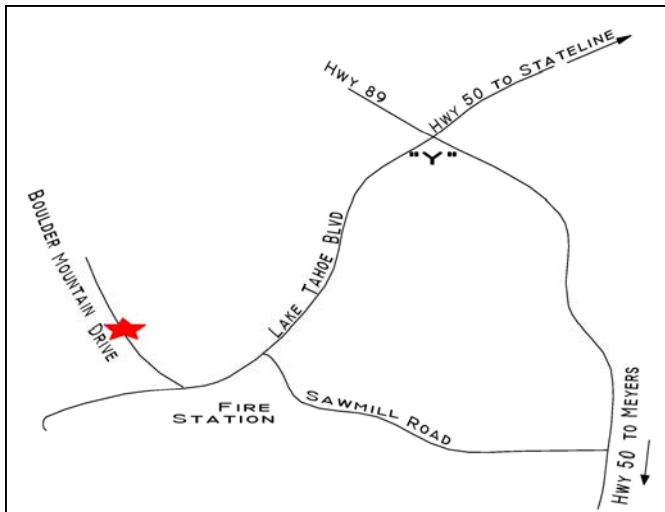
