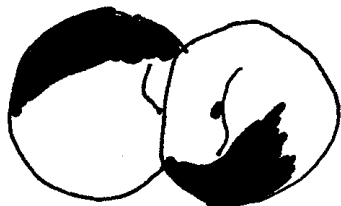


PEACH



Open center



Fruit grows on last year's wood.
Cut back 1/3 one year old twigs



Varieties:

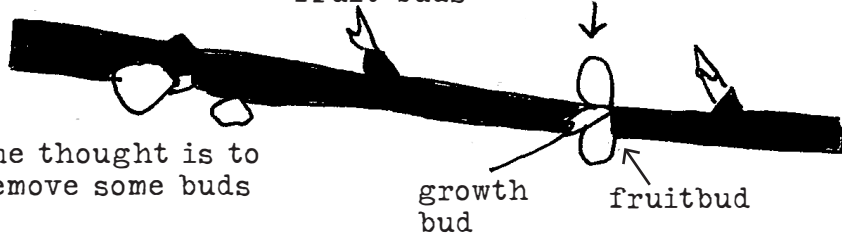
- 650 Fairtime
- 250 O'Henry (my fave)
- 800 Redhaven
- 800 Rio Oso Gem

Peach Curt:

This happens around here (usually in cycles). If you don't want to spray with copper sulfate (I don't!), pick off the dead leaves and new ones will emerge.

Triple Bud

You would remove the 2 fruit buds



One thought is to remove some buds

Young trees:

Avoid excessive summer pruning - stunts their growth!

Older trees:

OK, but some have fruit later
