

Greenfield 4-H Club Scholarship for 8th grade members

The Greenfield 4-H club offers a scholarship for graduating 8th grade members. A member may only be awarded the scholarship once. All members receive the same amount. The funds are held in the club's "scholarship" account and are budgeted for the year and are not removed until the qualifications are met. Members receive a \$25 gift card and a plaque.

Qualifications:

1. Must be an enrolled 4-H member in the Greenfield.
2. Must be graduating from the 8th grade.
3. Is a member in good standing with the club and county requirements. Has no letters or warning or issues in the club's files.
