- Understand, interpret, and maintain the camp's standards and policies.
- Possess an attitude and actions which continually reflect the 4-H philosophy.
- Work cooperatively with teen counselors and adult volunteers.
- Work cooperatively with Executive and Program Directors.

- Be an appointed 4-H Volunteer
- Complete a Camp Steering Committee Member position application.
- Oversee and maintain safety at all times.
- Assist with and end-of-camp inventory of supplies and equipment.
