Things to keep in mind when choosing plants for a pot

- All plants must have same water needs
- All plants must have same light needs
- Relative height and scale among plants
- Color scheme should be complementary
- Pot should complement plants in regard to color, style, and scale

- Shrimp Plant
- Coleus
- Calibrachoa (orange)

(White-washed terracotta pot illustrated)

- Dusty Miller 'New Look'
- White Periwinkle (Vinca)
- Euphorbia 'Diamond Frost'
- Licorice Plant (Helichrysum)

Coleus (Plectranthus scutellarioides)
Creeping Jenny 'Midnight Sun' (Lysimachia)
Dead Nettle (Lamium 'Purple Dragon')

Euphorbia 'Diamond Frost'
Ivy (Hedera Helix)
Licorice Plant (Helichrysum petiolare)
Maidenhair Fern (Adiantum raddianum)
