Purpose

This document outlines the Amador County 4-H Requirements for 4-H Youth to Exhibit at Fair. All requirements listed align to the 4-H Steps to Success policy and FAQ.

REQUIREMENTS	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Be a member in Good Standing
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete total hours for project completion as determined by Project Leader (minimum of 6 hours) Spanning from September 1st to the Monday of Fair in the current program year. The project leader's initial on the APR verifies this. Note: If a youth member fails to satisfy this requirement by the Monday of fair week, their fair eligibility will be revoked, they will not be allowed to participate in the fair as a 4-H member, and they will not be allowed to bring that exhibit to the fair.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete Annual Project Report (APR) Form
<input type="checkbox"/>	Meet requirements as set by the fair.
