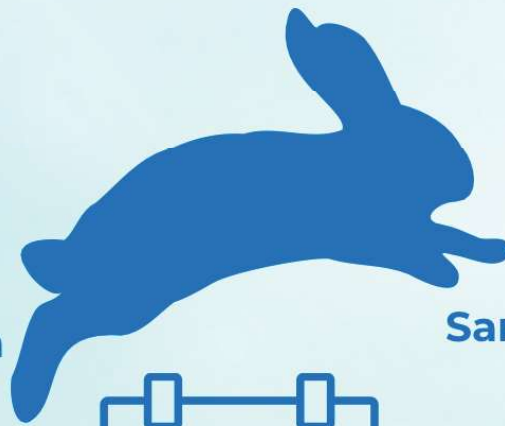

\$5 - Judging Contest

Description

Each contestant will be required to place four classes of four animals per class. This is a timed event of 7 minutes per class. The use of the ARBA Standard of Perfection at the judging table is encouraged. Judging classes may involve rabbits (including meat classes), cavies, fur and wool.

Contestants will identify 25 animals, both rabbits and cavies, listing the complete breed name as printed in the ARBA Standard of Perfection, the showroom variety, whether a 4-class or 6-class breed, and the registration variety of each of the 25 animals. No abbreviations are accepted.
