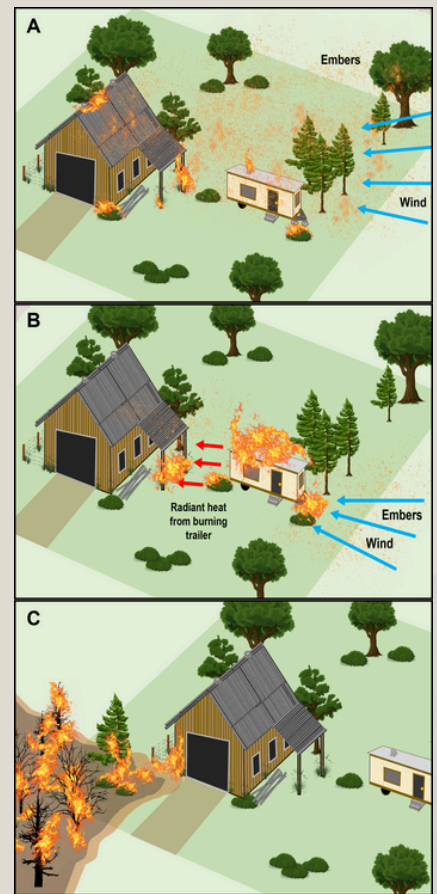
Date and Time: May 21, 2024 from 6:00 - 7:00 PM PST
