# MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 4:45 p.m. All attendees signed in.

The 2024-2025 Annual Budget was revisited and reviewed. Items were discussed in length and changes will be as follows: Remove "Council Meeting Food and Snacks," "Ambassador Interviews," and "Scholarship Interviews" and update with "Glenn County 4-H Meeting Meals and Entertainment." This will encompass expenses for county meetings, trainings and functions that currently do not have a line item. For example, calendar of events Planning, Key Leader check-in or training opportunities, county record book Evaluations, additional leader meetings, ect. Account that we have not currently used, will be inactivated. They can be reopened at anytime. The 2024-2025 Glenn County 4-H Budget will be reviewed and voted on at the September Advisory Team Meeting.

Discussions about items needing to be purchased. Meat slicer for Fundraiser Dinner and Cookhouse. The slicer requested was presented and it was table until next meeting when we have three quotes. The budget was finalized and voted on collectively and unanimously.

It was decided that committee chair thank you gifts will not be a budget item, but if an item was found that cost less than \$5.00 it would be taken into consideration.

A motion was made to provide the Cookhouse Chairs, Abby Alves and Becky Greunwald, with a \$50 gift card as a thank you gift for the continued support and successful undertaking of the Cookhouse. The motion was second by Lisa Humphreys.

Providing a mobile Livescan fingerprinting opportunity was discussed to accommodate new leaders and the need to for accessibility outside of normal working hours. Christine Kampmann shared she has called a few places and the best deal requires a minimum of 10 people. In the event that a sign up is created to fill the need, the Advisory Team would support absorbing the traveling fees.

The Incentive program was tabled until the next meeting.

The 4-H Buddy program idea could be filled with a County Ambassador Team or with in a club. The idea has been removed from future agendas.

Event support and representation on behalf of the Advisory Team has been tabled due to not having the full team in attendance.

Advisory team member suggestions for future years was an item for discussion, no names were offered.

Christine Kampmann shared that the Ambassador Advisor applications will be out this year and inquired about recommendations and encouraged others to think about who might be interested.
