



# 2025 4-H CHICKEN QUE OPEN HOUSE & CHICKEN BBQ POSTER CONTEST

## TIMELINE

- February ..... Begin work on posters! Please include all the information listed below!!!
- March..... Posters are judged at the club level. **ONE** winner in each age category goes on to county for judging. All Primary member posters go to county for recognition. Other entries may be placed in the community as a Chicken Que promotion by youth for credit in their record book\*.
- April..... Posters are judged at the April CCC meeting on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Only one poster per age division per club will be judged! One winner and two runners up in each age division (except for Primary Members) will be awarded and receive pins. All Primary Members will receive a participation pin. All posters will be returned to the club at the end of April CCC meeting to be displayed in the community. The winning posters may be returned by Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup> to be displayed at the Chicken Que event.

## AGE DIVISIONS

- Primary Members..... Aged 8 and under – *Receive a participation pin*
- Junior..... 9 and 10 years old - *Receive a pin*
- Intermediate..... 11 – 13 years old - *Receive a pin*
- Senior ..... 14 – 19 years old- *Receive a pin*
- Adult..... 19 and over – *Receive a special award, not a pin*
