Deadline to apply is Friday, April 11, 2025, at 5pm

Tehama County 4-H Council will be awarding scholarships again this year. Potential scholarships awarded will be in increments of \$1000.00, \$750.00, \$500.00, and \$250.00. Applicants will be selected based on cumulative results of the application and their growth in the 4-H program. Amounts awarded will be decided amongst the scholarship committee. Scholarship distribution will be given in one payment at the beginning of the first semester once the recipient has sent their class schedule or military acceptance to the Tehama County UCCE Office. Scholarship awards will not be held beyond one school year of the award date.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Graduating high school senior
- Currently, an active 4-H member with at least three years of active 4-H member in high school
- Achieved a minimum 2.0 accumulative grade point average and meet entrance requirements to a university, community college, vocational school, or military service.

All the above items must be completed and received at the UC Cooperative Extension-Tehama County Office by mail or hand-delivered no later than Friday, April 11, 2025, for consideration. Post marks will not be accepted, must be to Tehama Count UCCE office by April 11, 2025, by 5pm.
