

# 4-H Horse Fair Showmanship-Halter Show and Trail Trials

## **Guidelines for this year's combined event:**

- All fees payable Saturday morning.
- No dogs will be allowed.
- 4-H uniform must be worn, per discipline you are riding: English tack acceptable in trail trials. Riding boots, an approved **riding helmet**, and jeans. This includes all adult leaders as well!
- Sharing of horses is allowed in Showmanship and the Trail Trial competition.
- This event will follow the rules of the Fresno County 4-H Horse Project.
- **A W&KRP and Medical Release form must be submitted with registration form.**
- Each club participating must designate a 4-H leader to be present at the event.
- Any protests must be brought by the leader present directly to the event managers.
- All decisions of the event managers will be final. Approaching judges with comments, questions or problems are strictly prohibited.
- The event will be held rain or shine.

## **4-H Horse Fair**

- Open to **Fresno County 4-H Horse Members in Good Standing.**
- Showmanship Divisions will be 1<sup>st</sup> Year, Junior (13 & under), & Senior (14 & over). To be judged on the Danish system. Blue = Excellent, Red = Very Good, White = Good.
- Championship Round – All blues compete for Grand Champion and Reserve rosettes.
- Maiden Championship – All reds and whites complete for Championship & Reserve rosettes.
- Two Halter classes, to be judged on conformation will follow Showmanship.

## **Trail Trials**

- **Open to all 4-H Members wishing to participate.**
- Two divisions offered - Novice- walk/trot, walk jog only or Advanced- walk/trot/canter, walk/jog/lope. Class placing will be first–sixth place. Special prizes awarded to highest scoring horse and rider team in the each of the two divisions.
- No training aids, such as martingales and tie downs, will be allowed, although any bit will be acceptable
- The rider gets up to 3 attempts at each obstacle. There is a 3 minute time limit on each obstacle.
- This is a competitive event, not a schooling show; any help will constitute a zero on that obstacle.
- Please, no coaching from the sidelines. Rider must approach obstacle alone.
- All other riders/adults must wait outside the course until it is their turn to approach obstacle.
- Any deviation from this rule will result in a zero on that obstacle.
