Cucumbers	
China Jade Cucumber	Stunning jade-colored flesh and unmatched sweet flavor make this a superb snacking cucumber. A popular cucumber from northern China, it grows well both in the garden and in the greenhouse. The crop is believed to have been brought from western China to the east during the Han dynasty in 216 A.D. Cucumbers have long been selected and perfected in China for sweet, nutty gourmet flavor. This variety is an homage to those many years of natural breeding; the long, slender, thin-skinned fruit will develop without pollination, making a seedless and burpless cuke
Dragon Suhyo Cross cucumber	Long asian-style cucumber - thin skin
Garden Sweet	Bitter-free, 10-12 in. long, medium green fruits with faint stripes and smooth, thin skin.
Iznik F1 Cucumber	European cocktail cucumber that's seedless, spineless, thin-skinned, smooth, dark green, crisp and perfect for fresh snacking! Flavor is mild and cool, with a slight melon undertone. Short- vined plants are good when trellised, grown in containers or in the field
Japanese Cucumber Tasty Green	Crunchy, juicy and thin-skinned, long "burpless" Tasty Green Japanese cucumbers combine vigor and productivity with fine sweet flavor and especially refreshing crispy texture. The vigorous vines bear early, yielding abundant slender 10 to 12 inch fruits that never need peeling
Jibai Shimoshirazu	The sweetest cucumber we have tasted, this Japanese variety is a perfect snacking cucumber with no bitter flavor! Produces shorter, slightly thicker fruit than other Japanese varieties. Can be grown on the ground or on poles and is vigorous. Deep green fruit is about 7-8 inches long. Adapted to high temperature, humidity, and is disease and powdery mildew resistant.

Straight eight	Old-fashioned variety has been popular in home gardens for years! Produces perfectly straight, 8-inch fruits with a bright, sweet flavor.
Striped Armenian Cucumber	Unusual, slightly fuzzy, serpentine fruits are slightly ridged with alternating dark- and light-green stripes. Harvest from 8–18". Despite its shape, Striped Armenian is not a true cucumber, but is a member of the melon family

Tokiwa Tokyo Green Cucumter	Great Taste! The small, 9-inch fruit with tender skin and few seeds makes excellent pickles and sets the standard for slicing cucumbers; buttery soft, supremely sweet, and never bitter. They do well on fences and trellises, saving space in the gardens. Vines are almost mildew proof and well adapted to hot, dry summers.

Annina Eggplant	Glossy variegated eggplant with attractive teardrop shape. Selected for its high yield potential and striking color contrast compared to other varieties of this type. Spineless.
Black Beauty Eggplant	Large globe eggplant
Dancer Eggplant	Deep-pink Italian type. Semi-cylindrical fruits are mid-sized (7–8" long by 3–4" diameter), mild, and nonbitter. Plants are strong and high-yielding
Jewel Marble Eggplant (small not globe)	Beautiful heirloom variety that thrives in full sun and nutrient-rich, well-draining soil with a slightly acidic to Neutral pH (6.0-7.0). These impressive and abundant yielders are compact
Little Fingers Eggplant (small not globe)	known for their slender, finger-like shape and small size. They are typically harvested when they are as long as a finger, but can also be left to grow larger. They are known

Genovese Basil	Basil used primarily for pesto and other culinary applications. It's characterized by large, dark green, spoon-shaped leaves and a sweet, slightly peppery flavor.
Thai Basil	Purple stems and smaller, more narrow leaves with a slightly serrated edge, stronger, savory licorice flavor

Ambrosia Melons	One of the most popular melons for home gardens due to it's luscious salmon-red flesh and juicy, tender, extra-sweet flavor
Charentais Melon	A small, prized type of French cantaloupe known for its intense aroma, sweet flesh, and slightly orange hue. It's about softball size, with a smooth, hard, pistachio-grey skin

Aleppo	Northern Syria and Southern Turkey. Flavorful and sweet with a subtle kick of heat, popular in Mediterranean and Middle Eastern cuisines. Medium-sized, longer bell-shaped fruit ripens to a deep red
Anaheim	Upright plants are bushy and bear heavy yields of uniform, attractive peppers
Ancho Poblano peppers	Fresh, green version of the Ancho chili, while Ancho chiles are the dried, red form. The poblano pepper is known for its mild heat
Big Guy Jalapeno pepper	Large jalapeno - med hot
Big Jim Numex Pepper	New Mexico green chili - medium heat
CA wonder sweet	Largest open-pollinated, heirloom bell pepper
Fireworks	Add an explosion of color to your containers, window boxes, and garden beds with our vibrant Fireworks Pepper – a fun, flamboyant variety yielding heaps of edible, cayenne-like peppers in hues of orange, purple, scarlet, white, and yellow

Hot Aji Cristal	A Chilean aji pepper with a bodacious blend of citrusy flavor and heat. This slender, 4-inch pepper transforms from green to yellow and finally, a pale red, and the heat intensifies as the fruit reaches maturity. This crisp-fleshed pepper clocks in at about 30,000 Scoville Heat Units, which is six times hotter than a jalapeño.
Hot Cayenne	Slender, long peppers that turn bright red and are very hot.
Hot Chiltepin	Chiltepin chiles have a SHU of 50,000-100,000. Jalapenos measure 2,500-8,000 SHU. This means Chiltepin can be up to 40 times hotter than a milder jalapeno and almost 13 times hotter than the hottest jalapeno.
Hot Chinese 5 color	This aptly-named ornamental gives you purple, orange, cream, yellow and scarlet fruits — all at the same time! Their scorching-hot flavor will kick your salsas up a notch, too.
Hot Death Spiral	A gorgeous and intense pepper with a twisted shape that ranks among the world's hottest! The menacing fruit is contorted and wrinkled with a fierce little scythe-shaped tail.
Hot Hungarian Hot Wax	Smooth, tapered, and moderately spicy fruits avg. 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" and mature from pale yellow to orange red, and finally, to a vibrant red
Hot Jalapeno	Great hot pepper to start due to their ease and versatility. The heat is between 2,000 and 8,000 Scoville Units.
Hot Pepper -Fresno	Conical-shaped fruits are thin walled, avg. 4" long, and ripen to a bright red. Their flavor is sweet, mildly hot, and very good.
Hungarian wax	Thin skin with a thick flesh due to its immaturity and and a sweet hot flavor varying from warm to moderately hot.
Jalapeno	Great hot pepper to start due to their ease and versatility. The heat is between 2,000 and 8,000 Scoville Units.
Lunch box	Red, yellow, and orange Lunchbox snack peppers
Mini Mixed Bell Pepper	Beautiful mixture of miniature bell peppers

Orange Bell Peppers	A more mature form of green bell peppers, developing a rich orange color and a Sweeter flavor as they ripen on the vine.
Padron Pepper	Mild to medium roasting pepper - similar to shishito
Poblano (Baron)	This pepper is about 1,000 to 2,000 scoville so it is not very hot has a good flavor and mild heat.
Purple Bell Pepper	Develops a vibrant purple color when they're young and immature. They are known for their unique appearance and a mild, slightly sweet flavor.
Red Bell (Red knight)	Big, blocky fruits are early to turn red.
Serrano (Santo Domingo)	Santo Domingo has a bigger plant than Altiplano and yields over a longer period of time. Fruit averages 4 1/2–5" long.
Shishito	An old Japanese heirloom bearing wrinkly 3 -4" fruits – crunchy and sweet with a delicious kick of heat. Emerald peppers ripen to a brilliant red – great to eat at any stage.
Sweet banana	Sweet, mild taste and they're about five times milder than the average jalapeno
Sweet GYPSY	Excellent flavor from yellow to orange to red
Sweet red peppers	Sweet red peppers
Thunderbolt Hybrid pepper	Marconi style sweet italian pepper - red

Black Beauty Zucchini	A hardy, easy-to-grow heirloom with tender, deep green skin and delicate ivory flesh. Black Beauty is delicious grilled, roasted, sautéed, fried and raw.
Center Cut Squash (Row 7 Seed Co)	A new chapter for the heirloom tromboncino, and an answer to ho-hum zucchini. Young green squash were selected for their sweet, nutty flavor and meaty texture.
Cocozelle Zucchini	A flavorful, heirloom Italian variety known for its distinctively striped, ribbed skin and rich, slightly nutty taste
Early Golden Summer Crookneck Squash	A popular summer squash variety known for its bright yellow color, curved neck, and tender, meaty flesh

Elite Hybrid/Zucchini	A super early French hybrid zucchini that is both high yielding and easy to pick. Medium green, lightly flecked cylindrical fruits
Green Zucchini Squash	Mild, slightly sweet flavor with a hint of earthiness
Grey Zucchini	Great-tasting, high-quality, gray zucchini squash. Yields are very good; flesh is firm, mild, and very tasty.
Hybrid Zucchini Pantheon	Classic Costata Romanesco appearance but superior uniformity, higher yielding, and easier to harvest. Improved upright bush habit with reduced spines. Firm flower attachment at marketable size and attractive, glossy fruit.
Juane et Vertus Scallop Squash	A gorgeous patty pan, pale cream in color with green stripes. This prolific French heirloom has a lush, creamy cooked texture and sweet, nutty flavor. Can be left to harden and eaten as a winter squash.
Lemon summer squash	A variety of summer squash with vibrant yellow fruits that resemble the shape of lemons
Tondo di Piacenza	This Italian heirloom forms dark green spheres that are easily sliced into rounds, revealing their creamy interior. Early and productive, the Tondo di Piacenza also tastes
Trombetta di Albenga	Italian heirloom summer squash is a vigorous climbing vine, producing many 12 to 15 inch, lime-green fruits with a curvaceous trumpet shape and a delicate mild taste with a hint of nutty artichoke flavor. Trombetta's flesh is seedless and firm and doesn't get watery or mushy like regular zucchini.
Tromboncino Squash	Also known as zucchini rampicante, this Cucurbita moschata is tender, mild, and nutty when harvested as summer squash. It can also mature into a flavorful winter squash when allowed to grow long.
White Scallop Summer Squash	A very ancient Native American heirloom squash, grown by the Northern tribes for hundreds of years. Great fried or baked. Flat fruit with scalloped edges--beautiful!
Yellow Straight Neck Squash	This early, prolific straightneck summer squash produces creamy yellow, tender fruit of excellent quality early in the season.
Yellow Zucchini	Yellow zucchini develops a golden color as it grows

Zapallito del Tronco Summer Squash	This Argentinian heirloom squash has a creamy, butterly soft flesh and an edible rind. It is also called avocado squash, due to the low moisture content of the flesh, making it creamy in consistency. A semi-bush habit and very productive with relative squash bug resistance and excellent heat tolerance.
Zephyr F1 Yellow Summer Squash	Distinctive, slender fruits are yellow with faint white stripes and light-green blossom ends. Harvest young at 4-6" for unusually delicious, nutty flavor and firm texture
Zucchini	Mild, slightly sweet flavor with a hint of earthiness

Assorted pumpkin	Assorted pumpkin varieties (not specified)
Burpee's Butternut Squash	Regarded by many as the best tasting winter squash. Compact bushes are a delicious, productive choice for smaller gardens
Honey Nut Squash	A mini butternut squash with a gourmet pedigree, widely regarded as one of the best-tasting squash of all time! This squash reaches just 4 to 5 inches long, making a single serving size and quicker to roast whole

Black Cherry	Sweet and robust, almost-black fruits with heirloom-quality flavor.
Cherry Tomato Chadwick	Popular, flavorful, and prolific heirloom tomato variety, named after Master Gardener Alan Chadwick. It's known for its unique sweet, tangy flavor and its ability to produce Large amounts of small, bright red cherry tomatoes on vigorous vines.

Cherry Tomato Rebel Star Fighter	A hyperspace treasure in the gardening galaxy, shaped like a tapering heart reminiscent of a starship streaking through space. This cosmic cultivar's skin dazzles with the colors of an aurora splashed with green, blue, red and black, yet once you slice inside you reveal a rich burgundy-red, colored like a galactic emperor's robes
Large Red Cherry	The Large Red Cherry Tomato, scientifically known as <i>Solanum lycopersicum</i> , is a cultivar celebrated for its prolific production and delightful taste.
Orange Sungold (Cherry)	Superb orange color and sweetest tomato flavor
Peacevine cherry	Prolific and sweet cherry tomato
Sungold cherry	Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes leave everyone begging for more. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season. Tendency to split precludes shipping, making these an exclusively fresh-market treat. The taste can't be beat. 15–20 gm. fruits. Indeterminate.

Beefsteak	Large, meaty tomatoes known for their size, often weighing over a pound and having a diameter of six inches or more. They have a classic tomato flavor, though some varieties can also be sweet. Beefsteak tomatoes are great for slicing and are a popular choice for salads, sandwiches, and burgers.
Better Boy	A classic, award-winning beefsteak tomato with superior disease resistance and juicy, meaty flavor
Better Boy plus	Red, more resistant Better Boy
Big Beef plus	Red, very tasty, long season - resistant Big Beef
Black Beauty Tomato	Heirloom variety known for its deep, almost black, skin due to high concentrations of anthocyanin. It's a meaty, rich-fleshed tomato with a smoky, sweet, and slightly earthy flavor.
Black Krim	Dark red-purple fruit, rich sweet flavor. One of the best. It always places high in tomato taste trials. It's very juicy. An heirloom
Box Car Willie	Big red sweet/tart tomatoes
Brandywine Red	Luscious, heirloom flavor is "very rich, loud, and distinctively spicy." The large fruits, often over 1 lb., have a deep pink skin and smooth, red flesh.
Carbon	Black, exceptionally rich yet sweet - excellent
Cherokee Carbon	Deep purple beefsteak, very tasty
Cherokee Chocolate	Dark maroon and rose slicing tomato
Cherokee Green	Green flesh - best tasting green
Cherokee Purple	An old Cherokee Indian heirloom, pre-1890 variety; beautiful, deep, dusky purple-pink color, superb sweet flavor, and very-large-sized fruit. Try this one for a real old-time tomato flavor.
Dr Wyche's yellow	One of best tasting yellow, tried last year and agreed
Early Girl	Red, improved resistance, all around good
Early Girl hybrid (not plus)	Early, slicing and a well known favorite
German Pink	New this year - poor germination rate, we'll see
Giant Buffalo Heart tomato	Huge Heirloom red tomato - sweet and delicious

Japanese Trifele	Pear shaped maroon with green shoulders. sweet.
Juliet	Smallish oval, in clusters, meaty, tasty, vigorous vine

Bee Plant	<i>Scrophularia californica</i>	The flowers are red to maroon and are so small that they are easy to miss. The wedge -shaped light green leaves are much larger than the flowers.
Black Sage	<i>Salvia mellifera</i>	<i>Salvia mellifera</i> is a small, highly aromatic, evergreen shrub of the genus <i>Salvia</i> native to California, and Baja California, Mexico.
Blue Flax	<i>Linum lewisii</i>	CA native, spring blooming perennial
California Aster	<i>Symphyotrichum chilense</i> 'Purple Haze'	Deep lavender blossoms. Blooms late summer through fall and often into winter with one-inch daisies opening from dark purple buds. This plant SPREADS VIGOROUSLY by underground rhizomes, so works best when constrained by a planter or garden box or used in a meadow planting
California fuchsia	<i>Epilobium canum</i>	CA native with scarlet flowers, spreading form, blooms all summer and fall, great for attracting hummingbirds + butterflies.
California Goldenrod	<i>Solidago velutina</i> ssp. <i>californica</i>	A showy and easy to grow late blooming native perennial. Spreads by creeping rootstocks where it can form a good-sized colony. Has spread slowly in our heavy clay soils with minimal water, but has the potential to spread aggressively in lighter soils especially with regular
Canyon Snow Iris	<i>Iris douglasiana</i> 'canyon snow'	CA native - evergreen perennial, part shade inland gardens - from HRG

Common Yarrow	<i>Achillea millefolium</i>	Yarrow is an all-star, popular plant choice among California native gardeners, including beginners! It is durable and easy to grow in a wide range of soil types and has low moisture requirements. It reseeds and spreads quickly, making it a good groundcover plant for lawn replacement.
Fingertips/String Bean Plant	<i>Dudleya edulis</i>	CA native-evergreen succulent with upright, fleshy finger-like leaves 8-12" tall; small white flower clusters above leaves in spring; full sun to part shade; good drainage; great in containers or rock gardens; attracts hummingbirds and butterflies; hardy to 10 degrees F
Firecracker Penstemon	<i>Penstemon eatonii</i>	Striking perennial with bright red, tubular flowers that attract hummingbirds.
Hummingbird sage	<i>Salvia spathacea</i>	CA native - needs shade, ok under oaks and walnuts - from HRG
Nude Buckwheat	<i>Eriogonum nudum</i>	CA native-perennial with basal rosette leaves and white or pink flowers on tall (up to 6') bare stems. Flowers attract many pollinators and seeds are food for birds. Full sun; very low water
Rosy Buckwheat	<i>Eriogonum grande</i> var. <i>rubescens</i>	An evergreen small shrub that grows to 1 foot tall with the branches lying prostrate and spreading to 3 feet wide. It has small spoon-shaped leaves that are a gray green on the upper surface and wooly below and in late spring through fall appear the inch wide pom pom clusters of vivid pink flowers that are held above the foliage
Scorpionweed	<i>Phacelia crenulata</i>	CA native - invasive, but great for a hill to keep people out - from seed
St. Catherine's Lace	<i>Eriogonum giganteum</i>	Large and showy buckwheat endemic to the Channel Islands of California. It flowers densely, in carpets
Toyon	<i>Heteromeles arbutifolia</i>	CA native - evergreen shrub/tree - from HRG

Western Blue Flax	Linum lewisii	CA native - needs very little water will continue to bloom with some water, blue flowers, From HRG
White sage	Salvia apiana	CA native - evergreen shrub, aromatic, low water, - from HRG
White Salvia	Salvia apiana	CA native, shrub size, bee magnet
Woodland Strawberries	Fragaria vesca ssp. californica	CA native - some shade, spreads by runners, tasty fruit - from HRG
Yarrow	Achillea millefolium	CA native - semi-evergreen perennial - white flowers fragrant, spreads easily and can be tough to remove

Bee Balm, Bergamot, Horsemint	Monarda West Acer Purple	Purple, Reaching a full 3' in height, with light green, fragrant leaves providing an effective color contrast, this bee balm begins blooming in mid-summer and continues well into the fall.
Bush Sedum	Sedum praealtum	Also known as shrubby stonecrop or green cockscomb is a small, woody succulent shrub in the stonecrop family that is native to Mexico.

Gallardia	Gallardia Pulchella	yellow & red Typically grows 12-18" (less frequently to 24") tall on upright stems that are mostly leafless at the top. Daisy-like flowerheads (to 2" diameter) feature rays in shades of red, yellow or red/yellow bicolor, with contrasting darker center disks (usually purplish).

Hollyhock	Alcea rosea	Purple, Alcea rosea, commonly called hollyhocks, are old garden favorites. The flowers grow on rigid, towering spikes or spires which typically reach a height of 5-8'

Love's Fire Echeveria	Echeveria agavoides 'Love's Fire'	Known for its vibrant red color and cluster-forming habit. It's an easy-to-grow succulent, making it a popular choice for beginners and experienced gardeners alike
Mexican Sage	Salvia leucantha	Herbaceous perennial, Fall bloomer with staying power, tall stalks of purple flowers
Penstemon	Penstemon x gloxinoides	Midnight, 4" Penstemon is a dramatically beautiful, tall, slender plant.
"Perfect Daisy"	Leucanthemum superbum	"perfect daisy" - perennial
Pincushion Plant	Scabiosa Atropurpurea	Black, For best results, grow <i>Centaurea cyanus</i> in moist but well-drained soil, in full sun
