Low growing evergreen perennial that produces attractive 8-10" spikes bearing purple-blue flowers throughout April and May. Most often used as a groundcover. It is dense, fast and easy growing. Can grow in shade to full sun which makes it ideal for filling large areas like banks and hillsides. Excellent for choking out weeds. Foliage is green in spring and summer, turning to chocolate brown in the winter.

Flowering evergreen fast growing perennial shrub that can grow quite tall if not pruned. 6'-10'. Easy to grow and not too picky about its environment. Very attractive to butterflies, bees and hummingbirds. Prefers full sun. Requires moderate to regular watering. Somewhat deer resistant.

The California fuchsia is a showy perennial shrub that grows 1-2' high with upright stems. It has gray-green foliage and bright orange-red tubular flowers and attracts hummingbirds. This shrub is a native to California and is drought tolerant. Does best in full sun. Colors from white, pink to orange and red. Gray foliage and green foliage. Wide leaves and narrow leaves. They commonly grow where there is extra moisture in the winter and spring, gradually drying through fall. They prefer cool sun, but tolerate part-shade or hot sun with moisture.

Prostrate rosemary is an easy to care for creeping perennial herb suitable for the herb garden, perennial beds, containers, and rockeries. The plant only grows to a height of about 2" to 1' tall and will spread 4 to 8' if left unchecked. Full sun, drought tolerant,

Needs at least six full hours of sun, well-drained soil and protected from the wind. Space plants at least two feet apart. Attracts birds, butterflies and hummingbirds.

'Hot Lips'

A vigorous evergreen shrub 4-5 feet tall and wide that blooms 7-9 months a year. Flowers can be red and white, white or red all on the same plant depending on the time of year. Grow in full sun or partial shade. Adaptable to varying amounts of irrigation. Cut back halfway in early spring when growth begins from the center of the plant. Trim as needed to keep neat. Attracts bees, butterflies and hummers.

Evergreen perennial. 3-4 ' tall and 3-6' wide. Stems to 1 ' . long bear whorls of 3/4-1-1/4 inch purple flowers. Blooms from fall through spring. To limit plant size and renew flowering, cut back close to the ground before spring growth begins or at end of bloom cycle.

Mediterranean perennial plant that likes light, well-drained soil, full sun to part shade, heat. Water only when the soil is dry to the touch. Both a culinary and ornamental plant. Zones 5-10.

Height: 4' Sun: full sun Moisture preference: low to normal Bloom period: summer Soil preference: tolerates clay, prefers sandy Description/Key features: showy, white with purple splotches in center of blooms that attract bees. Old fashioned, evergreen shrub good on slopes, along walls, heat tolerant and salt tolerant. Deer resistant.

California Wildrose

Height: 8-10'. Width: 8-10'. Easy to grow, native California thicket-forming rose. Open-pollinated blooms, white to magenta in color. Flowers in spring and summer. Attracts pollinators and produces rosehips for birds. Tolerates low water but benefits from supplemental irrigation during summer. Makes a good hedge plant.

Showy Penstemon

Height: 2-4'. Width: 3-4'. California native perennial herb with an upright, mounding shape. Spectacular violet or purple-blue flowers, the showiest of penstemons. Deer resistant. Attracts native bees and hummingbirds, larval host for many butterflies and moth species.

A CA native shrub that grows in canyons, streamsides and moist places, at elevations from 0 - 5000' in the Sierra Nevada. Deciduous, 3-13' tall and wide, has strongly scented flowers from late spring through early autumn of red, purple or brown. Part sun, tolerates a wide variety of soils, moderate water.

Erect, woody-based, green stems 2-4' tall, topped in spring by a thick, bottlebrush-like inflorescence of greenish-yellow flowers. Grow in dry to medium, well-drained soils in full sun-part shade. Must have sharply-drained soils, they dislike heavy clay. Plants generally have good drought tolerance, but appreciate some moisture in dry summer periods. Cut flower stems off at the base after bloom to provide room for newly emerging stems. Use gloves as sap is a skin irritant.

Also called Christmas Berry, California Holly. Evergreen perennial shrub or tree native to California. 6-25 feet. Can be pruned to form a single-trunked tree. Small white flowers appear in summer, followed by pea-sized bright red berries in the fall and winter. Flowers are attractive to bees and the berries are a favorite of birds. Drought tolerant. Appearance improves with pruning and moderate water. Full sun or slight shade.

A woody perennial, 2-4' high, 2' wide. Silvery gray foliage, tiny yellow flowers, pungent odor. Full sun, little to moderate water. Divide every 3 years.
